The Finance, Membership & Volunteer, and Policy committees met prior to the board meeting to discuss key work plans, receive updates from the staff, and craft recommendations for the board's consideration.

Actions Taken by the Board:

Nov. 13, 2023

- Voted to accept the 2022-23 independent auditors' report from Atchley & Associates.
- Voted to approve the 2023-24 Election Rules.
- Voted to approve the reactivation of Sharyland ATPE in Region 1.
- Approved the September 2023 board meeting minutes and 2023 House of Delegates minutes via consent agenda.



Feb 16–17, 2024

- Voted to adopt the ATPE Policy on Member Use of ATPE Brand Assets.
- Voted to engage Atchley & Associates to complete an audit of the fiscal 2024 financial statements.
- Voted to repeal and eliminate the board policy allowing Region Director substitution at board meetings.
- Voted to approve 2024-25 membership dues discounts as discussed in executive session. Dues amounts will be revealed in early April as part of the spring campaign.
- Approved the November 2023 board meeting minutes via consent agenda.
